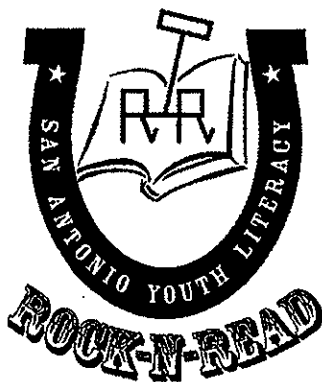

2007 SAYL GALA HONORS DOLPH BRISCOE

Patrons will have their last chance to experience the exhibit, *A Wild and Vivid Land: Stories of South Texas*, when San Antonio Youth Literacy honors former Governor Dolph Briscoe at this year's Rock & Read Gala at the Witte Museum.

Serving as Governor of Texas from January, 1973, to January, 1979, Governor Briscoe kept his promise of no new taxes, thus becoming the first and last administration to hold the line on taxes since World War II. In 2004, he received the Tom C. Frost Award from the University of Texas at San Antonio, an award given annually to honor a citizen who has provided leadership to important community and business endeavors.

Proceeds from the event will go to support San Antonio Youth Literacy's "Let's Read!" program.

About San Antonio Youth Literacy

San Antonio Youth Literacy (SAYL) provides the reading and comprehension-based program "Let's Read!" to at-risk elementary school children. "Let's Read!" program goals are: to provide opportunities for guided reading practice with a caring individual, to foster an enjoyment of reading, and to enhance motivation and self-esteem of at-risk children through the experience of reading.
